



SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

The charges as listed are valid from 1 July 2011.

All rates listed are indicative rates only and are subject to review by the Corporation if circumstances arise.

All rates listed are GST INCLUSIVE

TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

HARBOUR DUES

Charges levied on the Shipper / Consignee of the cargo for the use of the Harbour and Port Infrastructure (Channel), charged using Tonnes or Volume which ever gives the greater revenue.

TONNAGE / WHARFAGE RATES

Charge for Wharves and Infrastructure currently levied on vessel moored alongside wharf.

PAYMENT TERMS

The due date for payment is 1 month after the end of the invoice month.

OVERDUE ACCOUNTS

All Debts not paid prior to or within the 30 Days grace period and remain outstanding after the due date will incur a 10% Annual Interest Charge, charged daily until the balance is paid, if contracts are in place contract terms will remain.

LISTED RATES

*All the rates listed are indicative rates only and are subject to review by the Corporation if circumstances arise.
Where a Product, Item or Berth is not listed please contact the Corporation to obtain a rate.*

SHIPPING DOCUMENTATION

All documentation is required by GPC within 2 working days of a vessel sailing. Manifests should clearly state both weight and volume if applicable on all non-containerised cargos and charges will be levied on whichever gives the higher revenue. Also Cargo Origin and Destination is required.

STANDARD CONTAINER

A Standard Container as recognized by GPC is 19.875 foot (TEU) (6.0581mtr x 2.438 x2.59). Rates for containers greater than 20 foot will be adjusted on a pro rata basis. Minimum chargeable unit is a 20 foot container. Standard 20' container is 38.253 c.m.

In the case of goods which are levied at a rate -

- a) per tonne, harbour dues shall be payable at the prescribed rate per tonne of 1000 kilograms of gross mass - ie mass of goods plus mass of packaging, pallets, drums, bags or any other type of packaging;
- b) per cubic metre, harbour dues shall be payable at the prescribed rate per cubic metre of the volume of the goods of gross volume - ie total volume of goods and packaging, pallets, drums or any other type of packaging;
- c) per tonne and per cubic metre, harbour dues shall be payable in accordance with whichever of subparagraph (a) or (b) will produce the greater amount of harbour dues.
