GPC to officially take over the Port of Bundaberg

The day is fast approaching when the Port of Bundaberg will be handed over to the Gladstone Ports Corporation (GPC).

Sunday November 1 is the official date when the transfer becomes effective.

GPC Chairman Ian Brusasco said preparations were well underway to ensure a smooth transfer of ownership of the Port of Bundaberg to GPC.

"We are working closely with the staff at the Port of Bundaberg to make the transition as easy as possible," Mr Brusasco said.

Mr Brusasco added it would be business as usual at the port.
