Spinnaker Park closed to public

Gladstone Ports Corporation (GPC) has advised that Spinnaker Park will be closed to the public for at least 24 hours, while tree damage from strong winds and rain is assessed and cleared.

GPC's CEO, Leo Zussino, has also asked residents to stay away from the Marina parklands as there is also considerable tree damage at that site.

The size and number of trees that have come down in the strong winds is considerable, and Mr Zussino stressed GPC wanted to ensure public safety in both areas.

Advice will be provided when the Parklands are safe to access.
